As a Canada Soccer National Youth Club Licence holder, the Oakville Soccer Club adheres to Canada Soccer's anti-doping policy which has been created in conjunction with CCES and the CADP. OSC educates coaches, players and parents about this anti-doping policy through staff/volunteer meetings, player/parent meetings and Club policy manuals.

The <u>Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES)</u> is the custodian of the <u>Canadian Anti-Doping Program (CADP)</u>; the set of rules that govern anti-doping in Canada. The CADP consists of several components such as in- and out-of-competition testing, education, medical exemptions, and the consequences of doping violations. The CADP is compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code and all international standards.

Canada Soccer has adopted the CCES and CADP which means that the Club is a part of a world-class antidoping program that is designed to protect athletes' rights and ensure a level playing field. Canada Soccer's anti-doping policy reflects and supports the CADP.
