Program Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 10-minute warm up using activities provided by OSC under the direction of the volunteer coach• Players participate in a game which consists of two 20-minute halves (40-minute game)• 7 v 7 game format (including goalkeeper)• Fourteen (14) players per team (team size may vary depending on number of registered players)• player ratings from prior seasons• Referees officiate the game• No scores, no standings
Coaching & Program Facilitation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Volunteer coach leads the team throughout the season• Coaches must be 15 years of age or older (any coach under 18 must be accompanied by a guardian)• Coaches are required to complete the Respect in Sport Certification• Coaches are required to obtain/have a Vulnerable Sector Police Check (valid for 2 years)• The Oakville Soccer Club provides guidance and assistance to coaches throughout the season
