SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM STAFF COACH

OSC's Skill Development Program allows players at all ages and stages the opportunity to develop a wide range of skills across the 4 corners of the Long-Term Player Development Model. All sessions are created to develop the individual in various technical and tactical skill sets that are optimal to the players point of development. Alongside the Tactical and Technical attention, coaches will also be required to consider the psychological, social and Physical facets of the game, to deliver a well-rounded program for all players.

- Deliver OSC's SDP Curriculum for U6-U16 players
- Provide a fun, inclusive and engaging environment and learning experience for players
- Be enthusiastic, energetic, and engaged at all times
- Minimum Ontario Soccer age/stage appropriate certification preferred
- Set up/take down fields to ensure the program is run successfully for all sessions
- Report directly to the Skills Development Program Lead & assist with other tasks as required
- Compensation will be as discussed with Youth House League & Special Programs Coordinator
- Provide player feedback/evaluation on request to the Program Lead
- Successful applicants ages 18 and up will be required to submit a Vulnerable Sector Screening Check
