Program Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 10 minute warm up using activities provided by OSC under the direction of the volunteer coach• 50 minute game (2 x 25-minute halves)• 7 v 7 game format (including goalkeeper)• 12 players per team• Referee will officiate the game• No scores, no standings• Please note: if due to Provincial mandate players are unable to play games/scrimmages, the entire session will consist of activities/individual training until such a time as mandates change.• Please note that this is a combined U9/U10 age group
Coaching & Program Facilitation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Volunteer coach leads the team throughout the season• One referee is present at each game to officiate• Coaches must be 15 years of age or older (any coach under 18 must be accompanied by a guardian)• Coaches are required to complete the Respect in Sport Certification (reimbursed by OSC)• No formal soccer or coaching experience is necessary to volunteer in the House League Program• Coaches 18+ are required to have a Police Vulnerable Sector Check (valid for 2 years - reimbursed by OSC)• The Oakville Soccer Club provides consistent guidance and assistance to coaches throughout the season
