Coaching & Program Facilitation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Volunteer coach leads the team throughout the season• Coaches must be 14 years of age or older (any coach under 18 must be accompanied by a guardian)• An OSC Active Start Facilitator is present at each session to lead the activities and assist with the flow of the game• No formal soccer or coaching experience is necessary to volunteer in the House League Program• Coaches aged 18+ are required to obtain/have a Vulnerable Sector Police Check (valid for 2 years)• The Oakville Soccer Club provides guidance and assistance to coaches throughout the season
