| Program Format | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10-minute warm up using activities provided by OSC under the direction of the volunteer coach • Players participate in a game which consists of two 20-minute halves (40-minute game) • 7 v 7 game format (including goalkeeper) • Twelve (12) players per team (team size may vary depending on number of registered players) • Referees officiate the game • No scores, no standings |
| Coaching & Program Facilitation | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Volunteer coach leads the team throughout the season • Coaches must be 16 years of age or older (any coach under 18 must be accompanied by a guardian) • No formal soccer or coaching experience is necessary to volunteer in the House League Program • Coaches aged 18+ are required to obtain/have a Vulnerable Sector Police Check (valid for 2 years) • The Oakville Soccer Club provides guidance and assistance to coaches throughout the season |
