Coaching & Program Facilitation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Volunteer coach leads the team throughout the season• Coaches must be 15 years of age or older (any coach under 18 must be accompanied by a guardian)• Coaches are required to complete the Respect in Sport Certification• Coaches are required to obtain/have a Vulnerable Sector Police Check
