SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (SDP) LEAD STAFF COACH JOB DESCRIPTION

OSC's Skill Development Program allows players at all ages and stages the opportunity to develop a wide range of skills across the 4 corners of the Long-Term Player Development Model. All sessions are created to develop the individual in various technical and tactical skill sets that are optimal to the players point of development. Alongside the Tactical and Technical attention, coaches will also be required to consider the psychological, social and Physical facets of the game, to deliver a well-rounded program for all players.

THE RESPONSIBILITIES AND REQUIREMENTS OF AN SDP LEAD STAFF COACH INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Develop and deliver OSC's SDP Curriculum for U6-U16 players with approval from Coach Development & Recreational Programs Manager
- Supervise SDP staff coaches & ensure proper uniform attire is worn at all times
- Manage attendance of SDP staff
- Provide a fun, inclusive and engaging environment and learning experience for coaches & players
- Facilitate the operation of SDP (ensure all equipment is readily available for the SDP staff coaches to properly set up their own field, answer questions, distribute Club communications, etc.)
- Be on time for all shifts
- Provide bi-weekly reports on staff coaches including/but not limited to performance & attendance
- Submit monthly invoices using the template provided by OSC.
- Reports to the Recreational Program Manager
- Assist with other tasks as required
