Registration/ Payment Inclusions	• First instalment of \$1,299.50 due within 72 hours of team offer. • Second installment of \$1,299.50 due by October 2, 2026. • Please review OSC's Refund Policy here. • Failure to register and pay the fees by the deadline will result in forfeit of placement in the program. • At a minimum the initial instalment must be received before a player can begin participating in the program • If a player's fees are in arrears more than 14 days Oakville Soccer Club will suspend training and game play until arrears are paid and the player account is in good standing.
Commitment	• Program Start Date: Week of September 21, 2026. • Program End Date: Week of August 27, 2027. • No programming during the December Holiday Break and March Break. • Exclusion dates may vary for School Gym cancelations
Uniform(s)	• Each registrant is required to purchase the designated 2026-27 OSC Uniform Package at an additional cost to registration in January 2027. • The estimated cost of the package is \$300-\$350. • New Players joining the program for the indoor season (Fall and/or Winter) are required to purchase an indoor uniform kit. • Failure to purchase the package by the deadline will result in removal from the program; refunds will not be issued. • Additional items for purchase at an additional fee (ex. Extra training kits, fan wear etc.)
