Uniform(s)	• Each registrant is required to purchase the designated 2026-27 OSC Uniform Package at an additional cost to registration in January 2027. • The estimated cost of the package is \$300-\$350. • New Players joining the program for the indoor season (Fall and/or Winter) are required to purchase an indoor uniform kit. • Failure to purchase the package by the deadline will result in removal from the program; refunds will not be issued. • Additional items for purchase at a additional fee (ex. Extra training kits, fan wear etc.)
